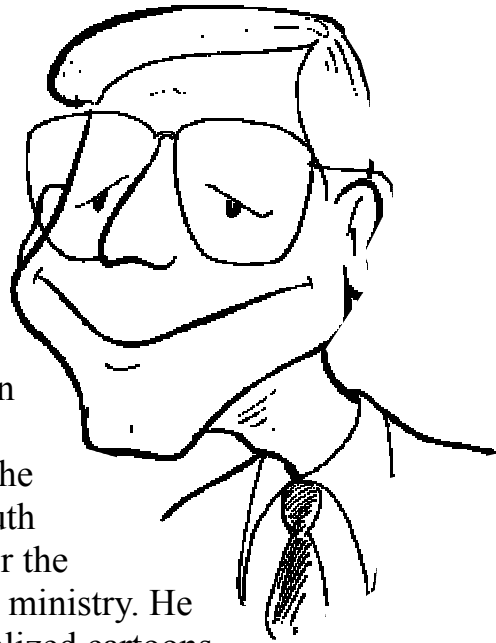


Doug Dillard...

...was cartoonist for *The Baptist Standard* for more than 30 years. He created “**Bro. Blotz**” for *Baptist Program* magazine in 1961 while serving as a minister of education. That same year he syndicated Bro. Blotz and his friends to churches for their bulletins and newsletters. Since then Doug has been better known for his cartoons than for his accomplishments among the pioneers of the field of church public relations and as youth evangelist, pastor, minister of education or the “forty-‘leven other things” he has done in ministry. He has given away more than 65,400 personalized cartoons at conventions and personal appearances. Since he “semi-retired” from the Radio and Television Commission in 1995 Doug has spent much of his time on the banquet circuit sharing his collection of “**PulpiTEARS**” – true, embarrassing incidents that happened in church. He also serves as a creativity consultant to religious organizations and operates his own web site where he gives away free cartoons for use in church newsletters at:
